Meet the 2014 Lake in the Woods Trustees

Eric Schmidt takes over as the President of the LITW trustees for the 2014 year. His roles and responsibilities for the Association include organizing the monthly meetings of the trustees, assembling the content for the Lakelines, serve as a main contact for neighbors and homeowners, and to enforce By-laws and standing rules. Please feel free to contact Eric with any general matters of the neighborhood or to find out how you can help the association.

Elizabeth Spencer is the 2014 Vice-President / Secretary. Her role is to assume the duties of the President in his absence and record the minutes of the meetings. She conducts correspondence with the group by distributing minutes and maintains attendance records.

Rich Dobre continues his tenure on the board as the Treasurer. Rich keeps full account of all monies received, prepares a yearly budget, and disburses funds as authorized in the budget. Rich keeps the list of all Association members and

is responsible for keeping in contact with buyers and sellers of property within LITW. His leadership and attention to detail is apparent each month in his report. Contact Rich with any questions regarding payment of dues or issues concerning buying or selling of properties in the neighborhood.

Jordan Mills stays on for 2014 as the LITW trustee for Recreation / Pool. Jordan is responsible for overseeing the management of the pool, lifeguards, and the other recreational areas such as tennis courts and beach area. Jordan should be contacted if there are any safety concerns regarding the pool area or if you hear or see any mechanical failures in the pool house. Jordan would like us all to be aware that he can not control the weather...yet.

Craig Hatch is once again our Aquatics Chairman. Craig takes great pride in the health of our lake and the smaller streams and ponds which feed into our community showpiece. Craig is responsible for lake and dam management and State required paperwork. Craig works with a management company to assess the health of the lake and to manage plant and animal life around and in the lake.

Dave Strauch rejoins the board and has assumed the role of Land and Safety Chairman. Dave will be overseeing the landscaping provided for the common areas and the spring and fall clean up days. Given that the natural beauty of our neighborhood is so important to homeowners, Dave will do all that he can to keep our entrances, fields, and roadways in great condition. Please encourage your neighbors to help with clean up days!

Kristin Erenburg will stay on for 2014 as the Architectural Control Trustee. Kristin should be notified before any construction of a building, fence, exterior wall, or other exterior structure begins. These plans should be submitted in writing. Kristin reports on any structure and premises that are not in good repair and not being maintained neatly. Please contact Kristin regarding any questions concerning the building restrictions within our neighborhood.
