The trustees are pleased to announce that the bid for dredging the sediment pond has been awarded to Gradeworks, Inc. Pool Update


A message from Recreation Trustee, Eric Schmidt

Have you seen the view from the look out behind Patterson's Fruit Farm on Caves Road? How about the corn maze at Szalay's Farm in Peninsula? Get out and explore all the wonderful outdoor activities NEO has to offer! Taking care of the pool is a group effort. This year in particular I had assistance from and want to thank Jordan Mills who is always my primary backup when I'm not around, and he certainly had to help quite a bit this summer. All our lifeguards did a great job of daily chemistry checks, keeping me informed of supply needs, and for the most part helping to remove the daily influx of frogs before the first swimmers arrived.
